BIO:

Alan Morphew is a Modern Folk Rock singer / songwriter from Los Angeles. He grew up in NW Iowa, and today makes that his home for over half the year.

After years of studying voice he is an incredibly powerful vocalist, ranging from sweet falsettos to emotional power vocals. His songs are catchy and melodic with strong choruses and meaningful lyrics. Alan has been compared to Jeff Buckley, John Mellencamp, Tom Petty, and Rob Thomas.

Alan sang on Neil Young’s 2006 album "Living With War." He also played trumpet for TSOL. While managing a popular North Hollywood recording studio, Alan engineered for many artists, most notably Tupac and Kiss. Alan has also recorded and toured in Germany.

Alan has received several awards for his music and songwriting from organizations including The L.A. Music Awards, Unisong International Songwriting Competition, Kweevak Music Awards (Portland, OR), and the All Access Music Awards (Los Angeles).

Alan released his third CD, “The American Dream,” in Nov. 2008. Two songs from “The American Dream” had already received Top 20 Finalist awards in the 2007 Unisong International Songwriting Competition. The CD was produced by Alan Morphew and mixed by James “Jimbo” Barton (Matchbox Twenty, Eric Clapton Unplugged) and Andy Hayes.

Regularly performing intimate solo acoustic shows as well as full rock band shows across the U.S.A. Alan has played in 17 states from the West Coast to The East Coast, the Midwest, and the South.
